

Procedure for hiring an external contractor to produce content and provide communication advice for the new <u>www.interreg.eu</u> website Call for tenders

Changes compared to previous tender

On behalf of the Interact Programme, the Interact Office Viborg published a call for tenders on April 11th, which was annulled due to mistakes in the tender documents. These mistakes have been corrected, and a new tender process has now been published.

Below, we list the changes included in this new tender compared to the previous one, document by document.

Terms of Reference document

• **Page 4 - "What to include in your offer"**. The right to use the server was added as follows:

"For orientation, Interact expects the total amount paid on this contract to be less than EUR 200 000 (excluding VAT). This amount is expected to cover release 1 and 2 of the website, as well as Operations and Maintenance, the right to use the server and Customer training until 31 December 2029. For that reason, there is a CAP for how much these things can cost. The CAP is calculated as:

- The price of Release 1 & 2 (excluding VAT)
- The price of Operations and Maintenance for 5 years (offered monthly price * 12 * 5) (excluding VAT)
 - The price of Support for 5 years (offered monthly price * 12 * 5) (excluding VAT)
- The right to use the server for 5 years (offered monthly price * 12 * 5) (excluding VAT)

Offers where the abovementioned prices accumulated are more than a total of EUR 200. 000 (excluding VAT) EUR, will be rejected without evaluation."

• Page 5 - "What to include in your offer". The following text was removed:

The Solution Design (annex 2) also describes a potential release 3. Some or all of the functionalities described in release 3 may be executed by the Supplier, if requested by

Interact and if agreed between the parties, as part of the "On-demand tasks", and invoiced following the IT consultants' hourly rates indicated in annex 3.

- **Page 7 "Overall economic consequences sub-criterion 40 %".** The following text was added:
 - "Right to use the server for 5 years (offered price * 12 * 5) (excluding VAT)

• 10 % of the accumulated amount of the hourly rates from Article 4. IT Consultants hourly rates, based on the estimated amount of hours, times the price per hour (offered price per hour * estimate of hours / 10) (excluding VAT)"

• **Page 4 - "Timeframe and scope of work".** The following new deadlines were included:

02/06/2024: Deadline for questions about the Contract. **09/06/2024** (by 23:55, CET): Deadline for bidders to submit proposals. 21/06/2024: Interact expects to notify bidders about the outcome of the selection procedure. No information will be provided before that date as regards the status of the evaluation of offers.

Annex 1: Requirements Specification

- **Pages 4-5: Evaluation requirement 0.16**: the assumed date for starting the plan has been updated so that it indicates the following: "When making the time schedule, the supplier shall assume that the date of the Contract is 27.06.2024."
- Page 5: Evaluation requirement 0.20: the word "English" was added to the following text (see underlined): "The CVs shall contain a description of their job title, role in the project, allocation in the project from inception until release of the website, education, <u>English</u> language skills, relevant experiences including the entity the experience was performed for, a description of the projects and what tasks the person carried out in this project."

Annex 3 Prices

Page 2: Article 4 "IT Consultants hourly rates": A column with number of hours was added to the table, as well as the following text: "The estimate of hours is non-binding for the Contracting Authority and merely for the purpose of Evaluation".

Draft contract

- Pages 2 and 3: The use of the server was added to articles 3 and 4.
- **Page 3, article 6, the dates** were updated so they read as follows: "Prior to the date of the Contract, the Contractor has made an initial Methodology Plan, by participating in the bidding from the 24th of May to the 9th of June".
