

Risk-based management verifications (RBMV) in the Interreg event will focus on implementing risk-based management verifications for the 2021-2027 programming period. This period marks a significant shift from previous practices, emphasising the need for management verifications proportionate to the risks identified ex-ante and documented in writing. Our event aims to provide a platform for Interreg programme institutions to discuss and exchange practical approaches, first results, lessons learned, and potential pitfalls in this new framework

Objectives

- Remind participants of the legal requirements for management verifications in 2021-2027.
- Address open questions and concerns about RBMV, collectively exploring potential solutions.
- Discuss the lessons learned in developing methodologies for RBMV, including practical examples from Interreg programmes.
- Discuss the first results of the RBMV approach.
