

This approach can significantly enhance project management and increase Interreg's visibility within Cohesion Policy.

Keep.eu is the platform where Interreg centralizes the knowledge generated by its projects. Whether you're familiar with keep.eu or new to it, this webinar will be valuable. You'll learn about the platform's offerings, including how to access and leverage its vast knowledge base.

Key Topics Covered:

- Ensuring your projects are featured in both keep.eu and Kohesio (the European Commission's Cohesion Policy knowledge platform).
- Harmonizing your programme's list of operations with the remaining Interreg programmes
- Frequency of data updates on your programme's projects in keep.eu.

Keep.eu is an invaluable resource for both detailed inquiries and comprehensive research. It's no surprise that think tanks and academic institutions are regular users of the platform. In this webinar you will also learn how to use keep.eu to get answers to queries such as the ones below:

- How many Interreg projects were contracted in 2021-2027, overall?
- What projects are there in any field of work in your region or country since 2000?
- What are the contact details for experts and partners involved in Interreg projects from any given programme and field of expertise?
- Which documents were produced by Interreg projects, by type of document and field of expertise, and by programme?

Objectives

The two main goals of this webinar are to bring Interreg professionals up to speed on how to guarantee that their projects' data features in keep.eu, and in Kohesio, and to make sure that, as professionals, they benefit from knowing the potential of keep.eu.
