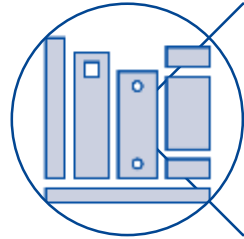

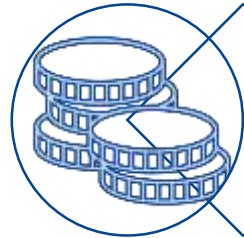

# Overview of assessment & audits

SCO	Off the shelf	Art. 53 CPR	Art 94 CPR
<b>Methodology</b>	No	Ex-ante or during implementation	AA ex-ante assessment (+EC approval via programme or programme amendment)
<b>Application</b>			

# Verification of the application of an SCO methodology

## Flat rate

- Basis costs: correctly allocated, eligible, no double declaration
- Existence of the cost category (except for indirect costs)
- Correctly calculated

## Lump sums and unit costs

- Pre-defined deliverables/ milestones achieved, justified
- No double declaration in case of combination with real costs
- Amount declared = unit cost x actual number of units delivered

# Verification of the methodology - examples

## Flat rate

- SCO flat rate of 15% of staff costs to calculate indirect costs
- verification of the eligible staff costs and that 15% of those are reported under indirect costs

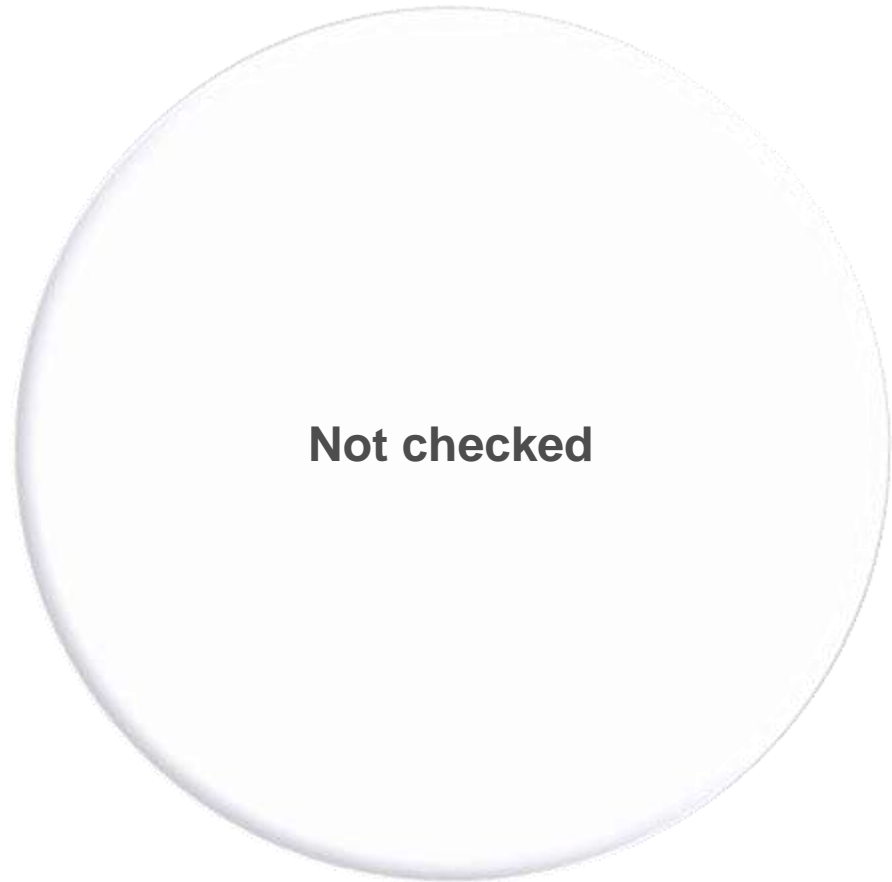
## Unit cost

- 30€ per participant per day in a project event (=unit), justified with a participant list
- verification of number of participants in participant list, correct multiplication of unit (e.g., 15 x 30€ = 450€)

## Lump sum

- 10.000€ for final conference
- verification that the final conference took place (e.g., agenda, signature list, photos)

# Aspects not checked



Evidence that the real costs correspond to the amount of the SCO

Actual expenditure incurred by the beneficiary linked to the costs categories covered by the SCO

Supporting documents to make sure that the amount reimbursed based on an SCO is spent for the same cost category
