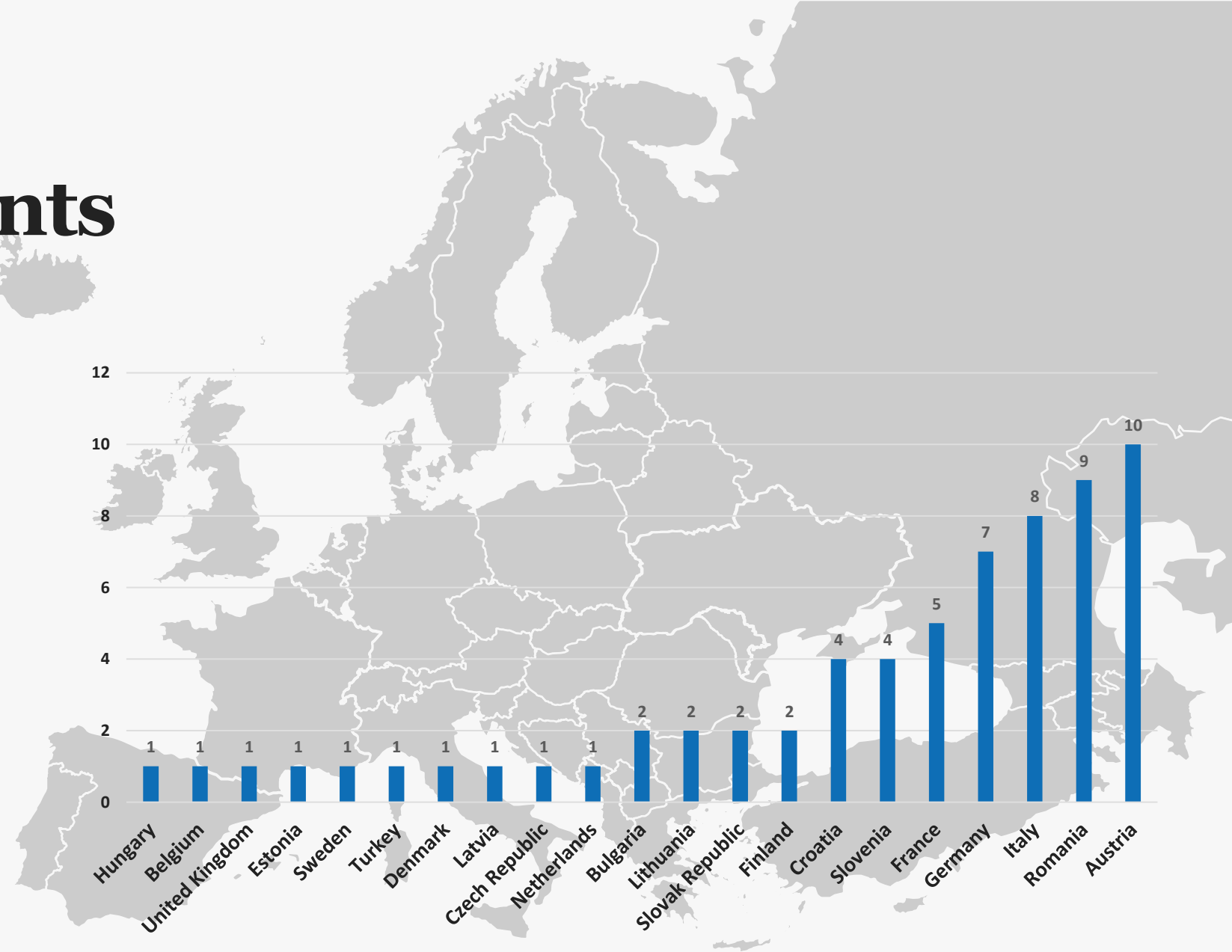

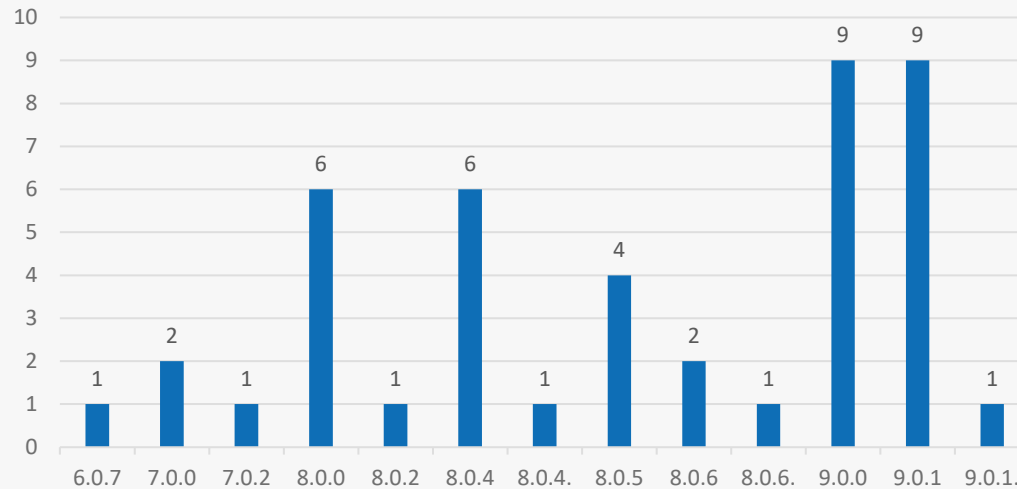

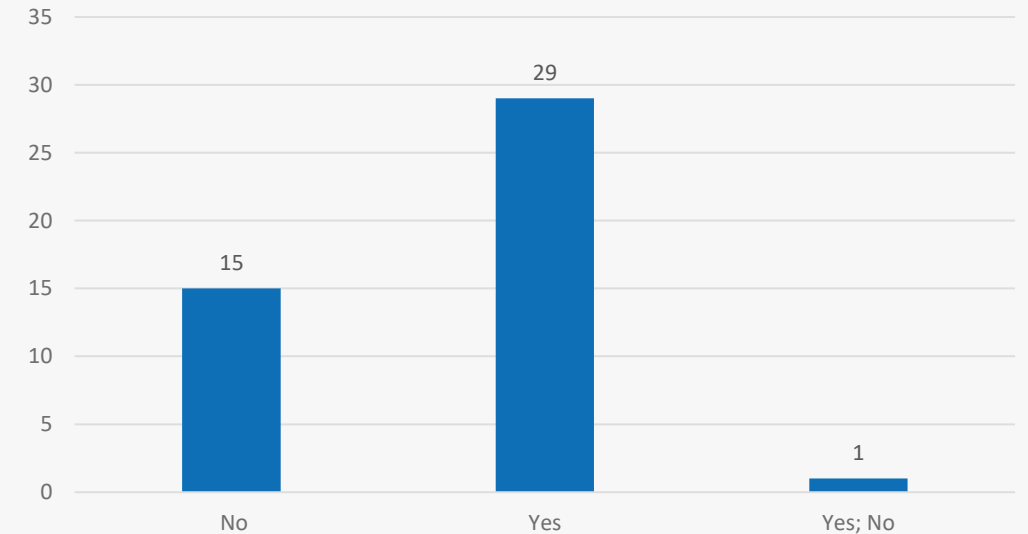
Did your programme signed a License agreement?

Which are your challenges when working with Jems

- Continual updates leading to adaptation challenges.
- Missing features from eMS, such as small text boxes.
- Challenges with reporting, analytics, export, and overviews.
- Close development planning in comparison to program planning.
- Difficulty finding IT service providers for customization needs.
- Inability to compare AF versions within Jems.
- Lack of a messaging service within Jems.
- Project management and resource allocation challenges.
- Meeting programme-specific needs.
- Upgrading MariaDB to version 10.6.
- Managing user expectations exceeding offered functionality.
- Lack of exports at project and programme levels.
- Integrating Jems into existing payment systems.
- Addressing loose ends and unfinished tasks.
- Familiarizing with Jems logic compared to eMS.
- Limited data export possibilities.
- Addressing applicant and JS concerns regarding detailed data exports.
- Managing translation changes.
- Using workarounds to meet program needs.
- Lack of user-friendliness and missing functions.
- Uncertainty about the timeline for feature releases.
- Customizing Jems to match programme needs.
- Difficulty assessing project budgets.
- Preparing own developments in a dynamic environment.
- Challenges adapting Jems to programme specificities.

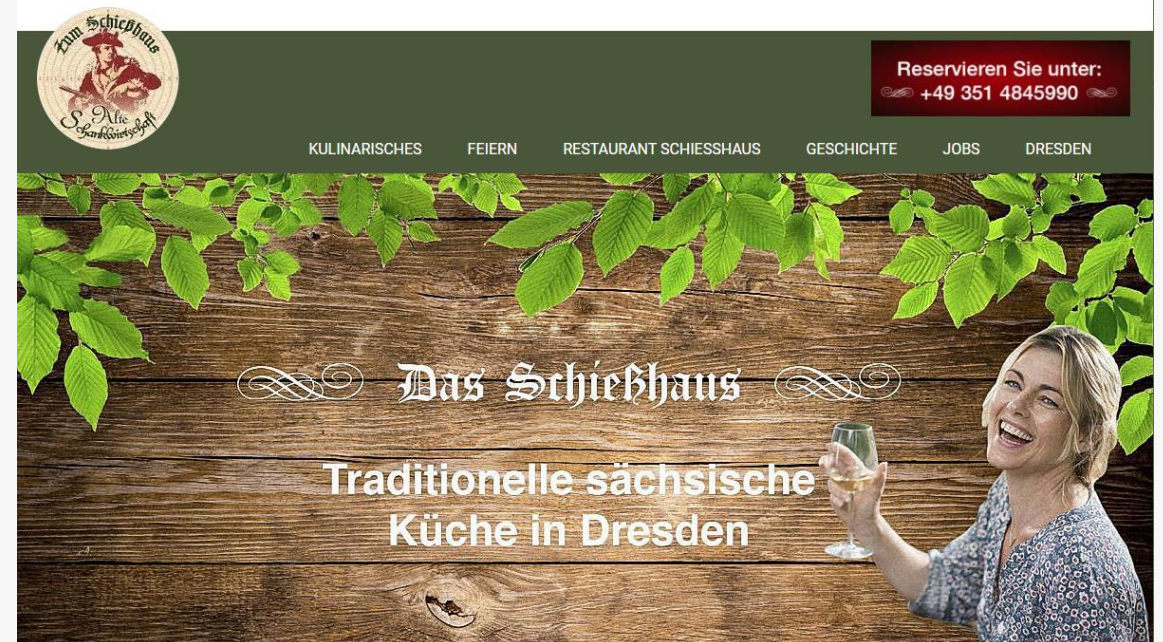
